

**VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO  
ORDINANCE NO. 2017-22**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR 2017,  
AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Clerk-Treasurer has notified the Council of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio that it is necessary for FEMA Grant compliance for the Carrollton Fire Department loan to move funds from the revenue account to the expense account, and to amend the 2017 appropriations within certain funds to anticipate necessary expenditures approved by council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO, that the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Carrollton be authorized to make the following additional appropriations and amendments to the appropriations for 2017 as follows:

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton and the reason for the necessity being that there exists an imperative need to amend the current appropriations to cover necessary expenses approved by council and to comply with the laws of the State of Ohio, and to ensure FEMA Grant compliance, and the ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
