ORDINANCE NO. 2017 –14

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A PAY INCREASE TO ALL NON-SALARIED  
FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICERS OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, Council of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio deems it necessary to increase the wage of all non-salaried full-time police officers of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to attract qualified candidates to fill the position of police officer in the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. The starting wage for a new hire as a full-time police officer in the Village of Carrollton shall be increased from \$14.00 per hour to \$17.00.
2. The wage of all existing non-salaried full-time police officers in the Village of Carrollton, Ohio shall be increased by \$3.00 per hour.
3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure that the Carrollton Police Department can attract qualified candidates and to ensure the prompt filling of a vacant position of police officer so that the Village of Carrollton Police Department is at full staff for the safety and protection of the officers and the public, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
