

**VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO  
ORDINANCE NUMBER 2017 - 40**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF UTILITY CONTRACTING, INC.  
FOR THE STATE ROUTE 43 (CANTON ROAD)  
DRAINAGE PROJECT,  
AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio has deemed it necessary to make storm sewer drainage improvements to State Route 43 (Canton Road); and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton advertised for competitive bids for said drainage improvement pursuant to the requirements of the Ohio Revised Code, and deems it necessary to accept the bid of Utility Contracting, Inc., of Youngstown, Ohio, which bid met the minimum bid requirement and was the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. The bid of Utility Contracting, Inc. of Youngstown, Ohio for the State Route 43 (Canton Road) Drainage Improvement Project in an amount not to exceed \$205,775.00 is hereby accepted.
2. Mark Wells, Village Administrator, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Utility Contracting, Inc. for said project.
3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure that the drainage improvement project is completed prior to the arrival of inclement weather, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
