WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio deems it necessary to establish a seasonal, part-time position of laborer in the Street Department for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio.

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio that:

1. There is hereby established a seasonal part-time position of laborer in the Street Department, which position shall be under the supervision of the Village Administrator and Street Department Superintendent.
2. The rate of pay for said position is hereby established at twelve dollars (\$12.00) per hour for a maximum of Sixty-four (64) hours per pay period (bi-weekly), with no benefits.

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY
IN THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on April 3rd , 2020, William J. Stoneman, Mayor, declared a state of emergency in the Village of Carrollton as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Carrollton deems it necessary to approve the local declaration of a state of emergency in the Village to protect the citizens of the Village and ensure access to all federal, state or private funds or assistance available through the federal, state and local declarations of a state of emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. The declaration of a state of emergency in the Village of Carrollton, Ohio as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic on the 3rd day of April, 2020 by William J. Stoneman, Mayor, is hereby approved.
2. The Mayor and/or Village Administrator are hereby authorized, in consultation with the Council, to enter such orders and take such action and execute such agreements deemed necessary to protect the citizens of the Village of Carrollton and to apply for and procure any federal, state or private funds, grants, loans or other forms of assistance available as a result to the Covid-19 pandemic.
3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation for the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure expedited approval of the local declaration of a state of emergency to protect the citizens of the Village and ensure immediate access to all federal, state and private assistance available as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

ACT POLICY FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE EXPANSION AND EMERGENCY
SICK LEAVE FOR THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, AND DECLARING IT AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the federal government passed the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) providing, among other things, family medical leave expansion and emergency sick leave provisions in response to the Covid-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Carrollton deems it necessary to approve a local policy for such family medical leave expansion and emergency sick leave.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. The Families First Coronavirus Response Act Policy Family and Medical Leave Expansion and Emergency Sick Leave for the Village of Carrollton is hereby approved as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.

2. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the employees and residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure the expedited approval of the emergency policies and the uninterrupted operation of the Village and the services provided to its residents, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE ODOT ROAD SALT CONTRACTS AWARDED IN 2020, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Carrollton, Carroll County, Ohio (hereinafter referred to as the "Political Subdivision"), hereby submits this written agreement to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT) annual road salt bid in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5513.01(B) and hereby agrees to all of the following terms and conditions in its participation of the ODOT road salt contract:

- a. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions established by ODOT in the road salt contract and acknowledges that upon award of the contract by the Director of ODOT it shall be bound by all such terms and conditions included in the contract; and
- b. The Political Subdivision hereby acknowledges that upon the Director of ODOT's signing of the road salt contract, it shall effectively form a contract between the awarded salt supplier and the Political Subdivision; and
- c. The Political Subdivision agrees to be solely responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in the ODOT road salt contract and agrees to hold the Department of Transportation harmless for any claims, actions, expenses or other damages arising out of the Political Subdivision's participation in the road salt contract; and
- d. The Political Subdivision's electronic order for Sodium Chloride (Road Salt) will be the amount the Political Subdivision agrees to purchase from its awarded salt supplier at the delivered bid price per ton awarded by the Director of ODOT; and
- e. The Political subdivision hereby agrees to purchase a minimum of 90% of its above-requested salt quantities from its awarded salt supplier during the contract's effective period; and
- f. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to place orders with and directly pay the awarded salt supplier on a net 30 basis for all road salt it receives pursuant to ODOT winter salt contract; and
- g. The Political Subdivision acknowledges that should it wish to rescind this participation agreement it will do so by written, emailed request no later than 24th, April 2020 by 12:00 pm. The written, emailed request to rescind this participation agreement must be received by the ODOT Office of Contract Sales, Purchasing Section email: Contracts.Purchasing@dot.ohio.gov by the deadline. The Department, upon receipt, will respond that it has received the request and that it has effectively removed the Political Subdivision's participation request. Furthermore, it is the sole responsibility of the Political Subdivision to ensure ODOT has received this participation request. Furthermore, it is the sole responsibility of the Political Subdivision to ensure ODOT has received this participation agreement as well as the receipt of any request to rescind this participation agreement. The Department shall not be held responsible or liable for failure to receive a Political Subdivision's participation agreement and/or a Political Subdivision's request to rescind its participation agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the following authorized person(s) that this participation agreement for the ODOT road salt contract is hereby approved, funding has been authorized, and the Political Subdivision agrees to the above terms and conditions regarding participation in the ODOT salt contract:

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A FIRE TRUCK, AND
DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council deems it necessary to purchase a new fire truck for the fire department; and

WHEREAS, in Ordinance No. 2020-08 council previously approved entering into a Request for Obligation of Funds to obtain USDA funding to purchase the fire truck.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. Village Administrator, Mark wells, is authorized to participate in the Sourcewell Cooperative Procurement and Contract Purchasing Program, through which the purchase of certain supplies, materials and equipment have been previously bid out through Sourcewell.

2. Village Administrator, Mark Wells, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with All American Fire Equipment of Canton, Ohio for the purchase of a Rosenbauer Pumper complete with Rosenbauer Commander Chassis per specifications, Sourcewell Awarded Contract No. 022818-RSB, through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program at a price not to exceed \$529,648.00, and dispensing with the competitive bidding process in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 735.053 and 125.04(B).

3. Village Administration, Mark Wells, is hereby authorized to enter into all contracts with All American Fire Equipment to purchase the fire truck.

4. Village Administrator, Mark Wells, is hereby authorized to enter into all contracts with USDA to obtain grant or loan funding to purchase the fire truck.

5. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure the expedited approval of the contracts within the time deadlines of the USDA funding cycle and to ensure an expedited commencement of the build-out of the fire truck, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
