AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF INSIGHT PIPE CONTRACTING, LLC FOR
SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION LINE IMPROVEMENTS, AND DECLARING IT AN
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio has deemed it necessary to line 8 inch sewer lines on Canton Road, 5th Street, NW, High Street, NW and alley areas in the Village of Carrollton; and

WHEREAS, Council advertised for competitive bids for said sewer lining project pursuant to the requirements of the Ohio Revised Code and deems it necessary to accept the bid of Insight Pipe Contracting, LLC of Harmony, Pennsylvania, which bid met the minimum bid requirements and was the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. The bid of Insight Pipe Contracting, LLC of Harmony, Pennsylvania to line 8 inch sewer lines on Canton Road, 5th Street, NW, High Street, NW and alley areas in an amount not to exceed \$163,012.50 is hereby accepted.
2. Village Administrator, Mark Wells, is authorized to enter into a contract for said sewer lining project.
3. This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure the sewer lining project is scheduled for completion in an expedited manner within the funding time deadlines established by the Ohio Department of Development Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Grant Program, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio has deemed it necessary to replace failing SCH 80 PVC raw and finished water lines and the backwash water line with ductile iron pipe at the Water Treatment Plant in the Village of Carrollton; and

WHEREAS, Council advertised for competitive bids for said water line replacement project pursuant to the requirements of the Ohio Revised Code and deems it necessary to accept the bid of Stanley Miller Construction Company of East Sparta, Ohio;

which bid met the minimum bid requirements and was the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. The bid of Stanley Miller Construction Company of E. Sparta, Ohio to replace failing SCH 80 PVC raw and finished water lines and the backwash water line with ductile iron pipe at the Water Treatment Plant in an amount not to exceed \$ 265,243.00 is hereby accepted.
2. Village Administrator, Mark Wells, is authorized to enter into a contract for said sewer lining project.
3. This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure the Water Treatment Plant water line replacement project is scheduled for completion in an expedited manner within the funding time deadlines established by the Ohio Department of Development Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Grant Program, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
